



Metadata for Open Access monographs

A metadata model for Open Access monographs

In this document, we present a metadata model for OA monographs. The model was developed as part of the project 'Investigating OA monograph services', conducted by Jisc and OAPEN. The model aims to find a balance in addressing the needs of various stakeholders and to keep the overhead in maintaining metadata at an acceptable level.

We do not think this is a definitive model for OA monographs, but rather a provisional list of metadata to be recommended to OA book publishers and other stakeholders. 
Main parts of the model

The proposed metadata model is based on five main parts: Book, Creator, Format, Funder and Collection. Save for Book, all parts can have multiple instances. For instance, the book "Fungal Disease in Britain and the United States 1850–2000: Mycoses and Modernity", has multiple authors (Aya Homei and Michael Worboys), it is available in multiple formats (XML and PDF) and it can be accessed through multiple online collections (PMC Book shelf¹, OAPEN Library ² and Directory of Open Access Books³). The book "Digitale Datenbanken. Eine Medientheorie im Zeitalter von Big Data" has received subsidy from multiple funders.

The main parts are defined as follows:

- Book a description of the monograph or chapter
- Creator the person(s) responsible for the content of the book
- Funder the organisation(s) supporting the research
- Format a description of the digital format(s) that have been made available
- Collection a description of the collection(s) the book is part of

The last column ("R") describes whether the field or part can be repeated.
